





The Sounds of Downtown

An eclectic mix of live music gives the *Downtown Disney*. District its distinctive party vibe.

you love the nightlife, the *Downtown Disney*. District at the *Disneyland*. Resort is the perfect place to indulge your passion—especially if you're in the mood for live music. From jazz musicians laying it down in Ralph Brennan's Jazz Kitchen° and mariachi bands spicing things up in Tortilla Jo's, to local and big-name acts rocking out in the House of Blues°, you'll find a wide range of musical genres represented here.

But even before you make it in the door of one of these venues, chances are you're going to get sidetracked by one of the mesmerizing musicians performing out on the promenade. After all, it's not every day you come across a professional hammer dulcimer player or, for that matter, a Juilliard graduate playing his electric violin.

The man responsible for assembling this eclectic collection of musical performers is Stan Freese, the Casting Director for the *Downtown Disney*. District. Part talent scout and part party planner, Stan is always looking for new and unique performers to keep things fresh and interesting.

"We can be a little looser than in the Theme Parks, because the *Downtown Disney*₈ District has a different vibe," explained Stan. And that looser approach means you'll see and hear things in the *Downtown Disney*₈ District that you may have never experienced before.

"We have a guy who plays a glass armonica, which is an instrument invented by Ben Franklin," said Stan. "And we just had an Army rock band from Norfolk, Virginia. They could really kick it!"

And while you could never get Stan to pick a favorite (that'd be like asking a father to pick his favorite child), certain performers have clearly developed a loyal following. Take Drew Tretick, for example. On nights when the world-renowned violinist performs in the Downtown Disney. District, rooms at Disney's Grand Californian Hotel. & Spa that overlook his venue often fill up quickly.

One reason *Downtown Disney*. District Guests become so enthralled with the performers is that they can get so close to them. "Little kids especially like to walk right up to the performers and see what they're doing," observed Stan. "It's an almost interactive experience."

Like any great party, the celebration in the *Downtown Disney*. District just keeps getting bigger and better. "We started out just doing weekends," said Stan. "Now it's seven days a week, with performers playing from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m." And as with any great party, word gets around that this is the place to be. "Once people found out how cool it is down here...and that it's free...and that there's great entertainment, it became like Bourbon Street and New Year's Eve all wrapped into one!"

Of course, you don't have to wait until December 31 to join in the fun. Make plans to take in the festivities at the *Downtown Disney*. District on your next visit to the Resort.



Main Street: How would you describe your Downtown Disney, store?

Anne Geddes: We designed the store to reflect the Downtown Disney. District's inviting atmosphere, so we could welcome families into a relaxing gallery setting that also offers a unique shopping experience. MS: Tell us about Beginnings.

Anne: I have always been fascinated by elements of nature at the moment of transformation. Babies are the human face of beginnings, but all of nature is caught in this insistent stream of seasons, of aging and rebirth, of concealment and bursting forth. Beginnings did take me on a journey of discovery to unwrap the everyday miracles of nature and place them side-by-side with newborns to reveal a deeper truth.

MS: What was the moment that Beginnings started to take shape?

Anne: It was during a chance visit to a small gallery in Sydney. I had seen a photograph of a bird's nest, which was an advertisement for what I thought was a photographic exhibition. When I arrived, it was a showing of real birds'

nests. I was deeply moved by these little nests, their incredible beauty and fragility. Everything about them was just so nurturing. And I began to think about these miracles of natureseeds, bulbs, cocoons and the miracle of pregnancy.

MS: Is the book a new chapter in your career?

Anne: When I saw the nests, my creative ideas began to flow again. I felt inspired to return to the studio and start photographing. Beginnings is the first project that I've done that I really do have a complete level of satisfaction with; I'm really proud of the work that I've done this year. I think it speaks more to what I really wanted to do in the first place than anything that I've done before.







new experience—as well as some of the most popular entertainment in Disney Parks' history—is Steve Davison, Vice President of Parades and Spectaculars for Walt Disney Imagineering Creative Entertainment. Recently, we sat down with Steve for a quick chat about the process of creating World of Color and to find out what it's like to see it finally come to fruition after all these years.

Main Street: So, Steve, how long has World of Color been in development?

Steven Davison: Well, we first started to develop the idea in 2005. It was like creating an animated film but with water, fire and animation. It took a few years to get the system together to run the show—it's quite a technical wonder underneath the water.


MS: How exciting is it to finally be able to present. World of Color to our Guests?

SD: I'm ecstatic! It has been very exciting to see a dream become a reality after so many years of hard work and imagining what it could be. The team has worked so hard to make this show a reality. They have overcome many technical challenges to bring this experience to life!

MS: Even before it debuted, World of Color was creating quite a buzz among Disney fans. Why do you think people got so excited about this particular show?

SD: Many new attractions and shows at the Disneylandar Resort have captured our Guests' imaginations before they opened. I thought it was important to show the construction of the fountain so Guests could watch it grow and become reality and to truly understand the scale of the show. By letting Guests in on the magic, just like Walt Disney did on the Wonderful World of Color television show, they really become part of it. For me that was an important element.




One small bear. Many big adventures.
